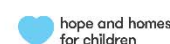

Aim of the project

Building the capacity of care professionals to better support young people in the preparation, transition and after care process.

PROJECT COMPONENTS

Scoping

Mapping of the leaving care system, qualitative questionnaire, peer-to-peer interviews in each project country

Training

800 professionals trained through both projects

Youth participation

Care experienced young people participate in all key activities as well as co-training professionals

Sustainability

All project countries develop sustainability roadmaps aiming at embedding the trainings into the child protection system in the long term

Local ownership

5-10 National partners in each project country – key stakeholders

Advocacy

All project countries develop national recommendations aiming at achieving changes in legislation and practice
